Neurorehabilitation, or neurological rehabilitation, refers to the medical and therapeutic process of improving an individual's overall skills, functions and wellbeing following a serious injury or neurological condition.

Following a brain or spinal injury, a neurological event such as a stroke, infection or brain tumour, or due to a degenerative condition like multiple sclerosis, an individual can experience enormous changes to their life – from physical and cognitive functioning to emotional and mental health.

SPECIALTIES

AMPUTATION

There are several potentially severe and serious implications people can experience after losing a limb. Their ability to perform everyday activities – that they could previously perform with ease – can be affected. Amputation can affect people's physical and social capabilities in addition to its physical impact.



With a brachial plexus injury, sensory and motor function of the arm may be completely or partially impaired and the patient often experiences severe neuropathic, or nerve, pain. Most traumatic brachial plexus injuries occur when the arm or the shoulder is violently or forcefully stretched or pulled.

BRAIN INJURY

A brain injury can be classed in several ways, ranging from mild and temporary to catastrophic and permanent. No matter how a traumatic or acquired brain injury is categorised, it is always likely to cause some level of impairment to an individual and require rehabilitation.

CEREBRAL PALSY

Cerebral palsy is an umbrella term for a group of non-progressive and permanent neurological conditions. It occurs when a child's developing brain faces serious injury, most often before or during birth. About one in 400 children live with cerebral palsy.









COMPLEX NEUROLOGICAL DISABILITY

Often associated with underlying chronic conditions such as multiple sclerosis, spina bifida, Parkinson's diseases and motor neurone disease, individuals living with severe and complex neurological disability can experience impairments in their physical, cognitive and emotional behaviours.



FUNCTIONAL NEUROLOGICAL DISORDER

FND is a condition that affects the functioning of the nervous system, resulting in a variety of symptoms that cannot be fully explained by underlying organic or structural abnormalities. FND can present with a wide range of symptoms that may affect movement, sensation, vision, speech, or coordination.



GUILLAIN-BARRÉ SYNDROME

GBS is caused by a malfunction in the person's own immune system that attacks the peripheral nervous system. As the disease progresses, the muscle weakness evolves into the paralysis of the muscles spreading from the lower to the upper half of the body.



MUSCULOSKELETAL INJURY

Musculoskeletal injuries can result in difficulty in movement and pain so rehabilitation programs are focused on improving the patient's ability to function, reduction in their symptoms, and raise their overall standards of health.



SPINAL CORD INJURY

SCI can result from various causes, such as motor vehicle accidents, falls, sports injuries, gunshot wounds, and other forms of trauma. Spinal cord injuries can have a significant impact on an individual's physical, emotional, and social well-being, and may require lifelong medical care, rehabilitation, and support.



STROKE

Stroke often causes impairment in memory, emotional disturbances, difficulty in speech and language, difficulty in movement of the muscles and joints and weakness, which limits as person's function and mobility.
