Dr Nour Hanga is a skilled and experienced Consultant in Rehabilitation Medicine and Clinical Director of the Central England Rehabilitation Unit at South Warwickshire University NHS Foundation Trust. He has more than 11 years of NHS experience and brings his clinical, leadership, research and teaching background to his growing medico-legal practice as a rehabilitation medicine expert witness.

His clinical practice covers neurorehabilitation, complex neurological disability, major trauma, stroke, spasticity management, capacity and best-interest decision making, and multidisciplinary rehabilitation. He provides clinical leadership for Level 1 and Level 2 specialist rehabilitation services, holds weekly spasticity and neurorehabilitation clinics, and supervises Clinical Research Fellows.

Dr Hanga has led national NHS England work on Long COVID health inequalities and was lead author of the National Commissioning Guidance for Post-COVID Services. He holds a Postgraduate Certificate in Medical Education and has broad undergraduate, postgraduate and multidisciplinary teaching experience.
